Dear Parishioners,



As we begin Great Lent this year, let us always keep before us the goal of this sacred time: "that our joy may be complete." This joy can only happen when we meet God "face to face". The before and after icons that depict Adam

& Eve speak about this divine encounter loudly. On this Sunday, we are reminded about the gift of forgiveness and also about the exile of Adam & Eve from the Garden of Eden (Paradise), because of their disobedience, their sin. They had lost their joy. And thus the human race did not know joy. Our God would not stand for this. Jesus, God's Son and our Messiah, was sent to earth to save us by meeting with us *face to face*. Such an encounter grants us joy without end, the gift of eternal life. This is

depicted in the *after* icon of Adam & Eve, the icon of the Resurrection, in which Our Risen Lord grants them and us eternal life, a joy that does not end.

Here are just a few moments (and there are many more) where we can meet God face to face. When we pray, we meet God, face to face. When we help others, we meet God, face to face. When we make better use of our time, we meet God, face to face. When we forgive, let go of grudges, we meet God face to face. When we truly listen to others, we meet God, face to face. When we reflect, before we speak, we meet God, face to face. When we fast, we meet God, face to

face. When we go to confession, we meet God, face to face.

Often on television or on some social media platform, we encounter the "before" and "after" pictures that demonstrate the changes that has taken place. Why not, take a mental picture of our "heart" now at the beginning of Great Lent. Over the next 40 days, invite and strive to meet our God "face to face". And as we do, there will be changes, there will be the restoration of joy. Such encounters, may be hard from time to time, but we must remember that they are not impossible. In fact, they are quite possible, when we discover in a new and fresh way how much God loves us.

May this Great Lent be filled with many special blessings for each and every one you.

Sunday of Forgiveness

Today, Forgiveness Sunday is the last day before the start Great Lent. The name of this Sunday indicates our desire for God's forgiveness that lies at the heart of these forty days. Today, also commemorates Adam and Eve's expulsion from the Garden of Eden, Paradise, because of their disobedience. Yet, despite this, God did not give up on them. As we pray in matins for this day,

"We were expelled of old, O Lord, from the Garden of Eden, for wrongly eating from the tree. But, O my God and Savior, You once again have restored us through Your Cross and Your Passion.

Thereby, O Master, fortify and enable us purely to finish Lent and to worship Your holy resurrection, Pascha our saving Passover, by the prayers of Your Mother"

Yes, Adam & Eve were expelled from the Garden of Eden, but as we glance at the Icon of the Resurrection behind our altar, we see that Our Lord restoring them back to life. This gift of new life awaits all of us at the conclusion of our journey through Great Lent.

FASTING REGULATIONS FOR GREAT LENT

Simple Fasting requires the faithful not to consume meat, during all Fridays throughout the year, including the Holy Season of Great Lent, with certain exceptions.

Simple Fasting is recommended on Wednesdays during the Holy Season of Great Lent for the intention of world peace, gratitude for the gift of life and for vocations to the priesthood and religious life.

Strict Fasting requires the faithful not to consume meat, eggs and dairy products. Strict Fasting occurs on the first day of Great Lent, Monday March 4 and on Good Friday, April 19.

The following have been given a general dispensation from fasting:

Persons who are spiritually or physically ill - sick and convalescent - those who work strenuously

 pregnant women and nursing mothers - those who have reached the age of 60 years

 Bishops, pastors and confessors may grant a dispensation from the fasting guidelines in case of necessity, in conformity with the spirit of our Church.


