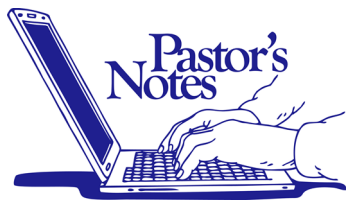

Dear Parishioners,



As we celebrate Thanksgiving this weekend, I am sure that the unexpected snowy and icy weather most likely will be the topic of some conversations. Surely, this weather has caused some inconvenience, but hopefully it does not prevent us from giving thanks to God for all our blessings.

The winter like weather reminds me of how one spiritual writer emphasized our need for “a rope to the barn” to keep us connected and safe, especially when life seems too much to handle. This spiritual author writes, *“There was a time when farmers on the Great Plains, at the first sign of a blizzard, would run a rope from the back door out to the barn. They all knew stories of people who had wandered off and been frozen to death, having lost sight of home in a whiteout while still in their own backyards.”*

Over the years, I have met many thankful people. One thing that I have noticed is that the level and depth of thankfulness is slightly different with those individuals who *held onto their ropes*. In other words, whether it has been physical sickness, financial instability, or personal traumas, those who held onto their faith, (the rope), seem to express a type of thankfulness that can only be influenced by tough times. The one common factor, regardless of that type of personal storm they traveled through was that they held onto the “rope of faith”. And this has produced a beautiful type of thankfulness.

For those who may have not have had such tough times, you may want to keep the following words in mind when life becomes stormy: *“When you reach the end of your rope, tie a knot in it and hang on.* This type of “knot” will help us to connect with God and grow in thankfulness, while at the same time help us to avoid hanging onto the other type of “nots”, such as “not fair”, “not me”, “not qualified”, and “not now”.

Before closing, allow me to express a big “thank you” to all who came out on Tuesday and Wednesday for making our most recent perogy bee such a success. Your efforts are greatly appreciated. And yes, there was much thankfulness for the new dough roller machine.

Enjoy Thanksgiving and please know that I am very thankful for each and every one of you.

As of the end of August 2019 our parish is in a deficit position. Last year the parish's expenses were higher due to the significant major repairs made to our church building, for example, the basement windows and drainage. In 2019 there have been no major repairs undertaken. The current expenses only reflect the day to day operations of the church. As one can see the trend is not good. Donations are down over \$21,000 or 11%. As we look to the end of the year, all parishioners are asked to keep the needs of the Parish in mind as you make your financial offerings. Thank you for your generosity.

Stained Glass Window Update

We are in the final stages of confirming the sizes and will be ordering the windows shortly. As mentioned at the Parish Annual General meeting in March, there are enough funds in the Decorating Fund to pay for the windows, however, there are not enough funds to have the windows installed. The Parish is short about \$60,000. These funds need to be raised by Spring of 2020 so that the windows may be installed. Again, we ask you to consider helping the Parish meet this need. Once again, thank you for your generosity.
