Blessed Father Michael McGivney a 29-year-old priest started the Knights of Columbus 140 years ago and today the Knight's Councils serve more than 17,000 Parishes around the world

Today's Catholic family don't have a lot of free time to help on activities (all the time), so to keep your membership fresh and keep our families connected; potential members are being asked to become new Online Member as a part-time member.

Knight's groups look for new members to help our parishes on weekends with things that happen at mass, or to help in building maintenance and cleaning, or help feed the poor, or help raise money for community causes.

A catholic man can become a regular member, but we suggest that you start as an Online Member first for at least 6 months to get to understand who we are. The home office will keep you connected with regular information by email every 4 to 6 weeks, while you and your family help when you can. And then transfer into a local Council at any time.

But here's the thing:

- a) If you are a Catholic man, 18 years old or older you can become an "Online Member of the Knights for Free" for a year. Then if you want to continue after a year or join your local Council, that's your call.
- b) And if you become a member between Feb 1st and June 20th, 2022, our local group will earn a Rebate for your membership from the Provincial Council that a group can use in a Parish or area community to help more people.
- c) Did you know that all Manitoba Bishops, and Father Barry are current members of the Knights of Columbus?

If you are willing to sign-up as an Online Member for free, and we ask that you include our Council name and Council number when you get to that Online sign-up screen while on your computer at www.kofc.org/joinus

Signing up takes 5 minutes on your computer or smart phone Your free code is: MCGIVNEY2020
