I recall an episode of the tv show M.A.S.H from the 1980's when a crazed and war-weary officer has become despondent after learning that his girlfriend on leave has married another man. In his misery, he begins to exhibit irrational and

violent behaviour that disturbs and threatens the entire outfit. Unexpectedly, the company clerk calls him to the phone. When the officer picks up the phone, he hears his mother's voice. She listens with empathy to his heartache, as only a mother can, which de-escalates his wild actions and soothes his temperament. The lowly but wise company clerk arranged the phone call and remarks, "Sometimes, a guy just needs to talk to his mom...." Do you agree?

There are some things in this world that only a mother can help us to understand. If our earthly mother is no longer, or perhaps never was, around to hear our concerns, our Mother of Perpetual Help is always available. We usually succeed with a mother's guidance, advice, and help. Throughout Ukrainian history, there have been many instances where the Mother of God, responding to the supplication of the faithful, extended her mantle of protection over cities and monasteries under siege. We pray for her supernatural and spiritual support to continue today in Ukraine. In other places, such as Lourdes, Fatima, and Guadalupe, the Blessed Virgin appeared with messages or special instructions to deepen our relationship with her Son. It is interesting to note that she usually appears not to kings, political leaders and important people, but to youth and children who are innocent in their faith. It follows that all forms of life, especially human, need to be protected. How Are They Connected?

In 1969, the government of Prime Minister Pierre Trudeau passed a Law which allowed therapeutic abortions to be performed. In response, women from the Catholics Women League at Christ the King Parish in Winnipeg worked for the formation of League for Life. This led to registration as a corporation in 1970 and as a charity in 1974. Christians of many faith traditions and people of good will united to help save the lives of the pre-born. The movement grew and was run through various affiliate groups across Manitoba.

Volunteers and staff ran the first League for Life office on Des Meurons. Pat Sonnen, registered nurse, was the first executive director, and was a brilliant and brave leader for all. She debated Dr. Morgentaler (the abortionist who performed five thousand illegal abortions) live on radio. League for Life in Manitoba held annual banquets that featured esteemed guests such as Dr. Bernard Nathanson (former abortionist turned pro-life advocate) to affirm the humanity of the pre-born.

League for Life became Life's Vision Manitoba Inc. and continued to advocate for the voiceless. Life's Vision brought the pro-life message to dioceses, spoke with students in and outside of the classroom, and continued to do pro-life work through Life's Vision affiliates across Manitoba.

Continuing in our vision of a life-affirming Canada, Life's Vision moved its office to Steinbach, Manitoba, and is now Life Culture, under the leadership of Susan Penner.

Life Culture Canada has become an umbrella for many more life-affirming initiatives. These initiatives demonstrate that the pro-life movement responds to the needs of beginning of life and end of life protection and advocacy, as well as every moment in between. Current initiatives include:

Angel Baby (pregnancy and infant loss support),
Generation Life (pro-life youth),
In the Waiting (infertility support),
Save the 300 (educational campaign),
the Church Ambassador Program,
CareTogether (end of life and caregiver support), and
Horizons for Hope (a Palliative Care Toolkit for Catholic Parishes)
