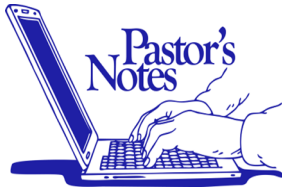

Dear Parishioners,

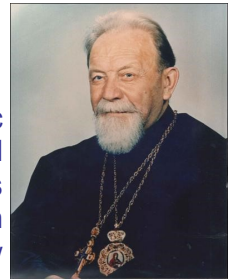
Today, we celebrate our parish's Praznyk. It is a time to give thanks to God for all the blessings that have been bestowed to us as a community of faith. It is also a time to honour our patron, St. Joseph and to give thanks for his intercession for all of us throughout the years.

Allow me to share the following thought about our patron: *Joseph did not let God's dream become his nightmare.* God spoke to St. Joseph through dreams, in which reassured and guided him. This helped Joseph focus in trust in God and not on his surroundings, which on the appeared on the surface as a nightmare. Just think about it, the one he was betrothed to was mysteriously pregnant, the trip to Bethlehem was a rough one, and running with Mary and child to Egypt to avoid death. All of the above could be considered material for a nightmare. Whether Joseph knew it or not by keeping his focus on God's dream, what might be considered a nightmare was never given a chance. If we find our lives turning into a nightmare, stop and recall everything St. Joseph went through. At these moments, it is important to seek his help, his intercession for us to have the strength to focus on God's *dream* for us and not on things that may be considered a *nightmare*.

On September 16th to the 22nd, the holy relics of Blessed Vasyl Velychkovsky were transferred from All Saints Cemetery to St. Joseph's Ukrainian Catholic Church. Since then, every Wednesday at 7 p.m., there has been a Blessed Vasyl Devotional Service. During the service, there are intercessory prayers for the needs of all participants and prayers that have been placed in the prayer box. Each service concludes with an anointing using Holy Oil blessed by relics of Blessed Vasyl.
