Preparing and cooking turned our Praznyk it into a fun social event. Too bad there were a few wispy uninvited guests in attendance by the cherry beverage dispenser.

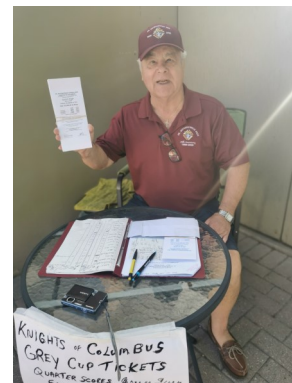
