**SUNDAY OF THE MYRRH-BEARING
WOMEN**

Today, the church glorifies the first witnesses of the resurrection, the myrrh bearing women. These women, these special witnesses of the resurrection, found themselves sent to preach to the apostles, making them as it were, the apostles to the apostles. Their love for Christ was great. While most of the apostles fled, so not to suffer the wrath of the authorities, these women stayed with Christ, revealing not only their devotion to Christ, but their courage, a courage which transcended that of most of the apostles. The myrrh bearing women went to give Christ perfume, but they found he offered himself as perfume for their souls. They did not abandon Christ, and likewise, Christ did not abandon them but strengthened them with his grace. He gave them a mission, to be the first to preach the fullness of the Gospel, to give birth, as it were, to the joy of the Christian faith by their proclamation of the resurrection to the apostles.

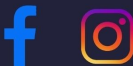
