Dear Brother Knights,

During the week before Easter, known as *Holy Week*, we focus on the greatest events of human history: the passion, death and resurrection of our Lord, Jesus Christ. The finding of the empty tomb is the joyful and hope-filled highlight of this Holy Week.

In the Gospel of Matthew, we hear how the myrrh bearing women came to the tomb. There they encountered the angel, who said, *You must not be afraid*. These words introduce the Good News. We no longer have reason to fear. Christ, by his own death, has broken the chains of death, which held us as prisoners.

The angel continued by saying: *Come here and see the place where He was lying*. We are all invited to examine the empty tomb and to see for ourselves the triumph of Christ over our enemy. Christ is risen from the dead. We know Christ lives because the power of His Resurrection continues to transform lives.

Finally, the angel said: *Go quickly now and tell the disciples*. The Good News of the Resurrection must be shared. This means that we who have experienced its joy and who trust in the promise of Christ must share that joy, trust and hope with those who have not yet experienced it. To make the most of this great Holy Day, we cannot merely enjoy it alone; we must share it with others.

May the light of the Resurrection shine brightly in all of our lives, so that we may truly proclaim
