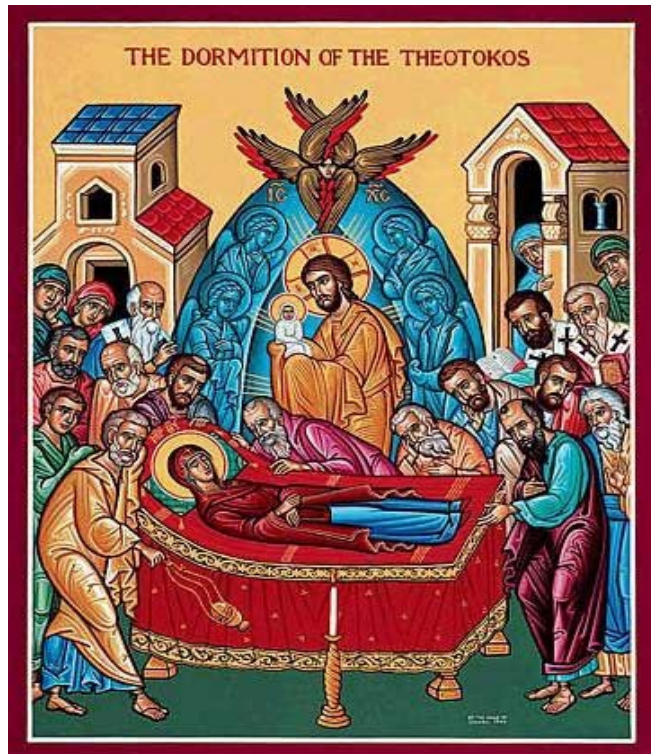

Pastor's

Dear Parishioners,

Presently we are in the high feast days time of August. Last Sunday we began the feast of the Transfiguration of our Lord on Mount Tabor. This feast day lasts 8 days, until this Sunday. Then on Tuesday we celebrate the feast of the Dormition of the Mother of God. This feast day lasts 9 days. The church places these two important feast days at the end of the church year (which ends August 31st) because both events declare and proclaim our dignity as followers of Christ. In the first, it reveals us to be filled with the light of Christ, a light that is meant to shine from us by our words and deeds. In the second, the beauty and surety of our eternal life is revealed in the falling asleep of the Mother of God. One can say that these feast days reveal to us the consequence of believing in Christ and accepting His Truth.

As we approach the second half of August, it is time to think of the catechism program for our children. I encourage all parents who have children or grandparents with grandchildren to participate in our upcoming catechism year. It is so important that our young not only learn about the ordinary curriculum offered in our schools but that they also learn and grow in their Christian knowledge and faith. This is not just a nice thing to do, but is essential to live a life united with God. We also need volunteers to pass on our faith to our young and become teachers in our catechism program.

The pandemic is hopefully "over". Therefore, our church life should return to normal. Many have become accustomed over the past years to not participate in the Divine Liturgy Services in church. Your presence is needed. Common prayer is very important if we are to develop into an alive Christian community. Please come back and become regulars if you have drifted away and have not been coming. Starting the Sunday following the September long weekend, September 10th, we will start our regular schedule of Saturday 5 pm in English, and Sundays 9 am mostly in Ukrainian, and 11 am in English. Both the 9am and the 11am Liturgies will be broadcasted online for those who are unable to be in church.

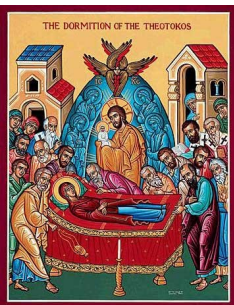

Dormition of the Mother of God Divine Liturgy Tuesday August 15, 9:00 am & 7:00 pm Blessing of Flowers

The feast of the Dormition or Falling-asleep of Mary is celebrated on the fifteenth of August. This feast, which is also sometimes called the Assumption, commemorates the death, resurrection and glorification of Christ's mother. It proclaims that Mary has been "assumed" by God into the heavenly kingdom of Christ in the fullness of her spiritual and bodily existence.

As with the nativity of the Virgin and the feast of her entrance to the temple, there are no biblical or historical sources for this feast. The Tradition of the Church is that Mary died as all people die. The Church teaches that Mary is without sin. In the Gospel of the feast, however, in the liturgical services and in the Dormition icon, the Church proclaims as well that Mary truly needed to be saved by Christ as all human persons are saved from the trials, sufferings and death of this world; and that having truly died, she was raised up by her Son as the Mother of Life and participates already in the eternal life of paradise which is prepared and promised to all who "hear the word of God and keep it" (Lk11.27–28).
