*From the
Pastor's
Desk*



Dear Parishioners,
The summer is quickly passing and soon the children will be in school, and all of our regular activities will begin. Parish life is three-fold.

First, we are a community of prayer, a community that believes in the Holy Trinity and worships our God together. Common worship is essential for a church to be alive and is our reason for existing. Jesus said that wherever two or three are gathered in prayer, there I am with them. When we worship together, we reflect the presence of our Lord and commune with Him. As a community, we proclaim that we belong to our God and that we live according to His designs. Prayer is the basis of our unity as a church community.

The second important aspect of a parish community is to be a social community. That is, we gather together to be together and to come to know each other. We help each other when someone is in need. We gather for meals and social events. We gather for education to learn about our faith, be it our catechism program or adult educational programs. We gather as groups - Ladies League, Knights of Columbus, Seniors, Outreach, perogy bees, church cleaning, altar guild, choirs, cantors, etc. In our particular case we also have the presence of the Shrine of Bishop and Martyr Blessed Vasyl with our volunteers and pilgrims who come daily. As a church community we build that community by making time to be with each other, work with each other and help each other.

The third aspect of a parish community is that we are to reach out even beyond our parish to those in need. A parish should be conscious of the needs of our general society and seek to respond to them. In some sense we are responding through our outreach program. We have our particular committee, but we are all encouraged to bring food for this program or to financially support their work. Associated with our Redemptorist ministry is our outreach at the Welcome Home. This has also been an opportunity for parishioners, either individually or as part of some group to become involved and to help. Now the phenomenon of new Ukrainian immigrants is upon us and the needs there are great. We have already started English classes, thanks to a few individuals volunteering. Much more can be done. We need to be creative as a community to respond to these new situations. I thank all those who are already committed to our outreach programs and I encourage others to get involved as much as it is possible, even with a kind word. Together and with the grace of God we can build St. Josephs to be a vibrant Christian Community.

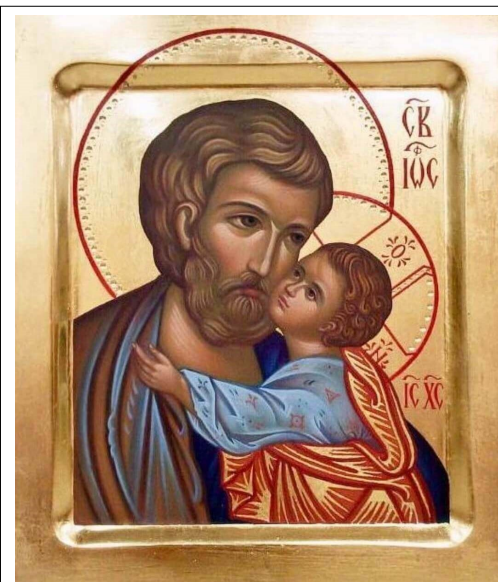
