

Dear Parishioners:

Next weekend our parish will be celebrating our PRAZNYK. The word "praznyk" means feast day/ celebration. On this day we celebrate our Patron, St. Joseph, the husband of the Virgin Mary with a Divine Liturgy and Water Blessing at 10 am followed by a lunch prepared by the Knights of our parish. Plan to be part of this event. St. Joseph appears very rarely in the Holy

Scriptures, but when he does, we see him as a person with a heart open to the Will of God. God the Father communicated to him often through an angel and a dream and St Joseph listened and acted. He did some extraordinary things: taking Mary, who was pregnant with not his child, to be his wife; escaping to a foreign country, language and all, with a mother and a child; and becoming the caregiver and mentor for our Lord. We pray that St. Joseph's example of openness inspires us to be open to whatever God desires in our personal lives and in the life of our parish. Do not be afraid to get involved. You might be surprised what hidden talents and gifts you have to offer.

A big THANK YOU to all who came out to the Perogy Bee. It was good to see all those who participated in the various tasks that a Perogy Bee involves. It was a time to reconnect with others, especially with those who live at the Holy Family Towers and are served there by Fr. Bohdan with a Sunday Liturgy. Last Sunday I began a series of sermons explaining the meaning of the Divine Liturgy. 
### Prayer to Our Mother of Perpetual Help
