Dear Parishioners:

In a few days time, I will be going on vacation for several weeks. It is my intention to be part of the ordination to the episcopacy of Bishop-elect Michael Behl, our former Redemptorist Provincial, in Pembroke, Ontario. I hope that your summers are going well.

We continue to help our new immigrants from Ukraine to have their homes furnished and supplied. Thank you to all those who were able to donate household items and furniture. The war in Ukraine continues to grind on. With the instability in American politics, it is unknown what the future will hold for military support in the future for Ukraine. Please pray that this support continues and even increases. Each day that there is lack of proper support means more and more people are being killed. Pray for peace. Also pray for victory for Ukraine, that their integrity of their borders be maintained and secured. Since I have been travelling to Ukraine yearly for so many years, my heart breaks when I see the destruction that is happening not only to the country but also to the hearts and lives of its people. I am seeing the effects it is having on my friends. Yet there is a spirit of resilience and strength, based on their faith in God. This past week the Synod of the Ukrainian Catholic Church participated by the bishops of the whole world concluded in Zarvanytsia, a great Marian Shrine, Ukraine. They held it in Ukraine for the first time since the war began. A major theme was having the church become a source of humanitarian aid for the desperate people especially from the war-torn areas, and to become a place of healing for all those wounded in body, soul and spirit. The Church in Ukraine is becoming a true source of outreach to those in need. They are also depending on support from Ukrainian Catholics around the world. That includes us. Hopefully we can do more fundraisers in the near future to support this war-time effort.

As we look forward to the fall, we will be in need of many volunteers. With the new comers present in our parish, we now have many children and even youth that need support and care through our catechism programs and hopefully also a youth program. The new Ukrainians are very talented, enthusiastic and energetic. Let us welcome them and help them to be fully involved in our parish life.

Just a reminder, the Cook Creek Pilgrimage will be in mid-August. Please plan to take part in at least some of the events and Liturgies.

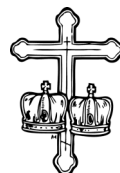
