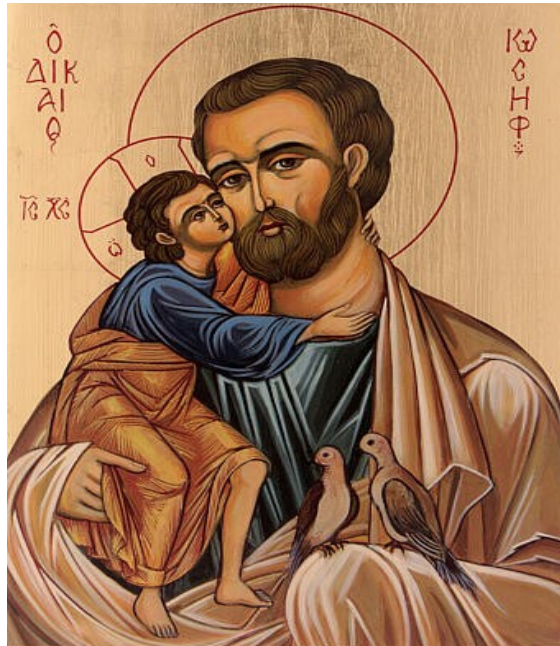

Dear Parishioners,

Today, September 1, our Church celebrates the New Church Year. Our church calendar follows the ancient Greek secular calendar which had New Year's Day as the beginning of September. With that our liturgical cycle begins again. The church offers us important days throughout the year to help us become more aware of God's tremendous love for us as we celebrate the events of Jesus' life and that of his mother the Blessed Virgin Mary.

Our first major feast day will be next Sunday - the Nativity of the Mother of God. The church marks every day of the year with some event of the life of Jesus and Mary, or the commemoration of some saint. The saints, people like us, are given to us as examples of true Christian lives for us to be inspired and to follow.

With the new church year, we at St. Joseph's begin our year's cycle and community life. I invite all those who have not come to church for a long time to make that effort to make Sunday a day for the Lord and a day for our church community. There are so many needs that we have as a parish. One physical need is to pay for our new furnace. We will need fundraisers and other projects to raise the funds for this necessary improvement to our physical structure. We need people who would volunteer for our maintenance committee. We need people who can become hall managers when we have some outside event, especially involving the kitchen. We need more volunteers for our catechism program, to establish a youth program, and many other community building projects that are possible. We could have more cantors/singers to animate our Divine Liturgies. We definitely need some "techies" to monitor our online productions during the Services. Our parish has been blessed with the influx of new immigrants from Ukraine who are making St. Joseph's their spiritual home. They bring new life to our parish. May we welcome them warmly and involve them in the life of our parish.

I am hoping to establish more formal English language courses for our new-comers from Ukraine. We need an ESL teacher (paid position) to conduct these classes. Please contact me if you are interested and available for this part-time position (three evenings a week).

Our parish Praznyk will be Sunday September 22, when we will have one Liturgy at 10 am followed by a meal. Plan to attend.

I welcome all of you back after your summer vacation. May we have a spirit-filled, holy, and community building church year!

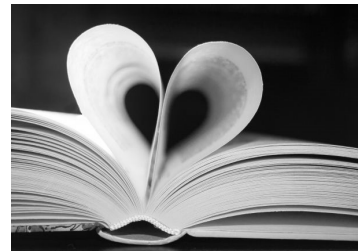
