Pastor's
Desk*



Dear Parishioners:

Much is starting to happen in our parish. This past week we had our first perogy bee. We could have used a few more people but overall it was a success. It was good to see so many parishioners who “rolled up their sleeves” and did all the various jobs there are to make the Bee a success. Thank you for the leadership and for all those who were able to come and help.

Also this past week we, hired a teacher for the English classes for the new Ukrainians, Svyatoslava Ivanyuk, originally from Kolomyya, Ukraine, who has been teaching foreign languages, English and others, for the last fifteen years. We will begin classes on October 1 (see bulletin for details). We still need a few more volunteers to help in this project (helping the students) and even in the administration. Please contact me if you can help.

As you know our new furnace (boiler) should be operational in a few days. It takes a few days to fire it up and check for any leaks etc. As you have seen in the bulletin we are still close to \$100,000.00 owing on this project. Various groups and individuals are planning fundraisers in the near future. Please support these projects and if possible get involved in making them happen. Details will be in the bulletin. Of course, donations are always welcome.

On Saturday (September 14) we celebrated the Exaltation of the Holy Cross. This feast day has both a historical element and a spiritual element. It commemorates the “re-finding” of the Holy Cross of our Lord upon which he gave his life and saved us. It was found in Jerusalem by St. Helena, the mother of Emperor Constantine in the early 300's. It was identified by the miracles that occurred to those who touched it. Later it was stolen by the Persians and in the late 400's it was brought back to Constantinople and elevated before the people on September 14. The cross is venerated solemnly by us as we kiss it or bow before it. It was the wood upon which Jesus saved us and conquered the power of evil. A blessed Cross to this day has the power of protection and a proclamation of our faith. Therefore we cross ourselves, we hang crosses on the walls of our homes, we wear crosses around our necks.

I will be in Toronto for Redemptorist meeting this coming week. This Sunday I will celebrate my 50th anniversary at Holy Eucharist Church in Toronto where I was for twelve years. I leave the parish in Fr. Ivan's and Fr. Yevhen's capable hands. Also I invite you to offer Divine Liturgies for your intentions. If you require a special date, please inform me in good time.
