

#### Dear Parishioners:

This weekend we are celebrating our parish Praznyk. We celebrate the existence of our church community, that God has called us to share our faith with each other by praying together, supporting each other and working together. Our parish was placed under the patronage of St. Joseph 72 years ago. St. Joseph is Jesus' foster-father. He was called by God to look after the Blessed Virgin Mary and then to be the one who would




