

Dear Parishioners:



We had a very beautiful celebration of our Praznyk. I thank all those who were able to come and participate in it. The Church was practically full. I thank the ad hoc choir (parishioners who came together in the choir loft to sing) under the leadership and direction of Lesia Sianchuk. It was so good to hear a "full" choir sing our ordinary melodies and help the whole church to pray. After praying and thanking our God for the

gift of calling us to be part of this parish, we also acknowledged that it was 22 years to the day since we transferred the Holy Relics of Blessed Bishop and Martyr Vasyl Velychkovsky. After the Liturgical service we were treated to a simple delicious meal in our parish auditorium. I thank the Knights of Columbus for providing the hamburgers and hot dogs and the UCWLC for providing all the salads. We had a chance to introduce all the new Ukrainians who were present and a chance to come to know them. Over all there was a wonderful and beautiful experience for all those present.

Catechism will be staring soon. Registration will be announced in our next bulletin. All children of school age are encouraged to participate. It is essential that our children be catechized, to learn the Christian faith and the Christian values. The world offers us a very different set of values. If we do not offer the Christian approach to life for our children, then they stand little chance to live their lives according to God's way. There will be a volunteer sign up sheet each Sunday in the hall to pick the dates that work best for you.




