Dear Parishioners:

Happy Thanksgiving! This weekend we in Canada celebrate Thanksgiving. Giving thanks is a very human gesture. We should develop an attitude of thanksgiving. There will be fresh baking, various Ukrainian culinary dishes (names I can't even pronounce), some crafts, various Crafts Vendors will be present, a dessert "cafe" and much more. The Ukrainian ladies have been working hard to prepare all this for us. The proceeds are going to our boiler fund. (It is good to have reliable heat in our church complex.)
