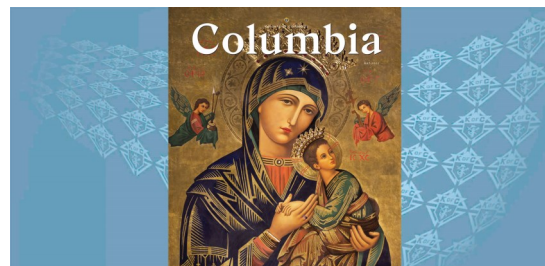
Congratulations with thanks are due to the brothers who worked with our parish UCWL to host the annual parish Praznyk on Sunday September 22. A great event!
