From the
Pastor's
Desk



Dear Parishioners:

I have not had a message for the past few weeks because of illness and other circumstances. As many of you know our Metropolitan has been ill with Covid, just after the retreat. He was in a very critical situation, but now, thanks to all the prayers, he is recovering well. Pray for his complete recovery.

Several weeks ago we had a very successful Yarmarok, that was mainly organized by our Ukrainian new-comers. It was good to see the parish pull together to make this event successful and profitable. Parishioners contributed baking, others worked in the kitchen preparing a variety of Ukrainian dishes, others looked after the cash boxes, raffle and entrance fee. There was a small "restaurant" serving Borscht or specialty tortes, baked by one of our new parishioner. Crafters were invited to come with their wares. We had some fifteen of them. All of the food and baking was sold. A big thank you to all who had organized this event, to all who volunteered their time and talents, those who decorated the hall and to all who came and were part of this Yarmarok. As was mentioned before, the new Ukrainians wanted to do this event to help raise funds for the boiler. The event raised a net of \$5,168.00 for the boiler and people had donated \$2,200.00 for medical supplies for our soldiers in Ukraine. Well done and thank you! Another Yarmarok is being planned for December 14th.

For the past two weeks we have begun our catechism program. I thank all the teachers who are volunteering their time and all of the parents who are bringing their children for this very important ministry in our parish.

This week we have **perogy bee** on Tuesday and Wednesday. As usual we need volunteers. Please come and share in this fruitful and profitable fundraiser.

On November 1, we commemorated 80 years since the Servant of God Metropolitan Andrei Shyptytsky fell asleep in the Lord. Metropolitan Andrei was the Metropolitan of Lviv from 1900 to 1944. A holy and good pastor of his people. He was a great visionary and did much to form our Ukrainian Catholic Church. He gave us our first bishop (1912-28), Blessed Niceta Budka. He introduced the Redemptorists to Ukraine in 1913. He made two trips to Canada in 1910 and in 1922. In 1922, he travelled across Canada to collect funds for the thousands of orphans that were in Ukraine, because of the First World War. He was a wise and loving Father for the people. His cause is now before the Vatican for sainthood.
